Executive Summary

The Sustainable Urban Governance through Augmented Reality (SUGAR) project aims to develop innovative best-practice protocols and guidelines on Sustainable Urban Governance and specifically Public Participation through Augmented Reality. Urban Design and Planning worldwide have long been criticised for their lack of meaningful public consultation and participation in the process of the making of our cities. Currently, the existing practices of consultation and participation are within the confines of council meetings, complex form filling and survey reports that most often than not carry little weight towards the decisions made by the planning authorities. For the last decades, the concept of Participatory Planning as an approach of designing has been heavily incorporated in many disciplinary fields. This project investigates the role of participation as the process that users, and other stakeholders, are actively involved in the decision-making process through the approach of achieving Sustainable Urban Governance and utilising innovative immersive technologies (specifically AR). We argue that the application of participatory design in the design process is essential to provide economically and socially sustainable outcomes. SUGAR aims to empower both citizens that seek ways to participate in the decision-making process for the design of their cities and neighbourhoods and stakeholders that would like to involve the public actively in the process of shaping their environment creating a lasting and meaningful impact.

This deliverable 2.5 is created in accordance with the description of work of Work Package 2 of SUGAR, particularly Task 2.5. This task aims to demonstrate the project's presence in the media, the endeavors for successful networking, and to present the project's mailing lists.

Introduction

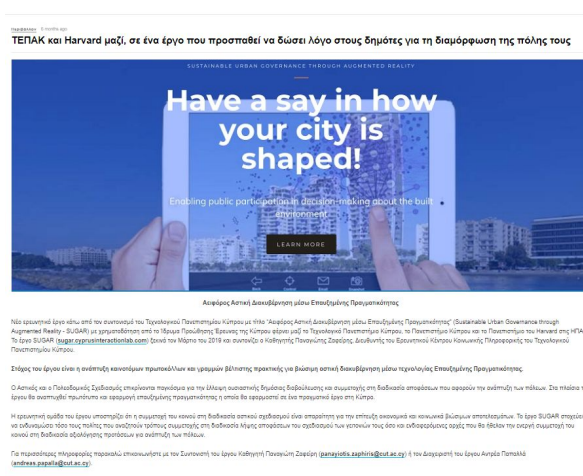
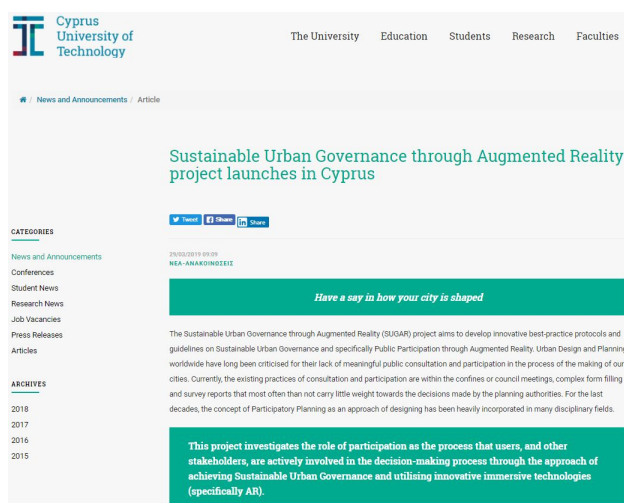

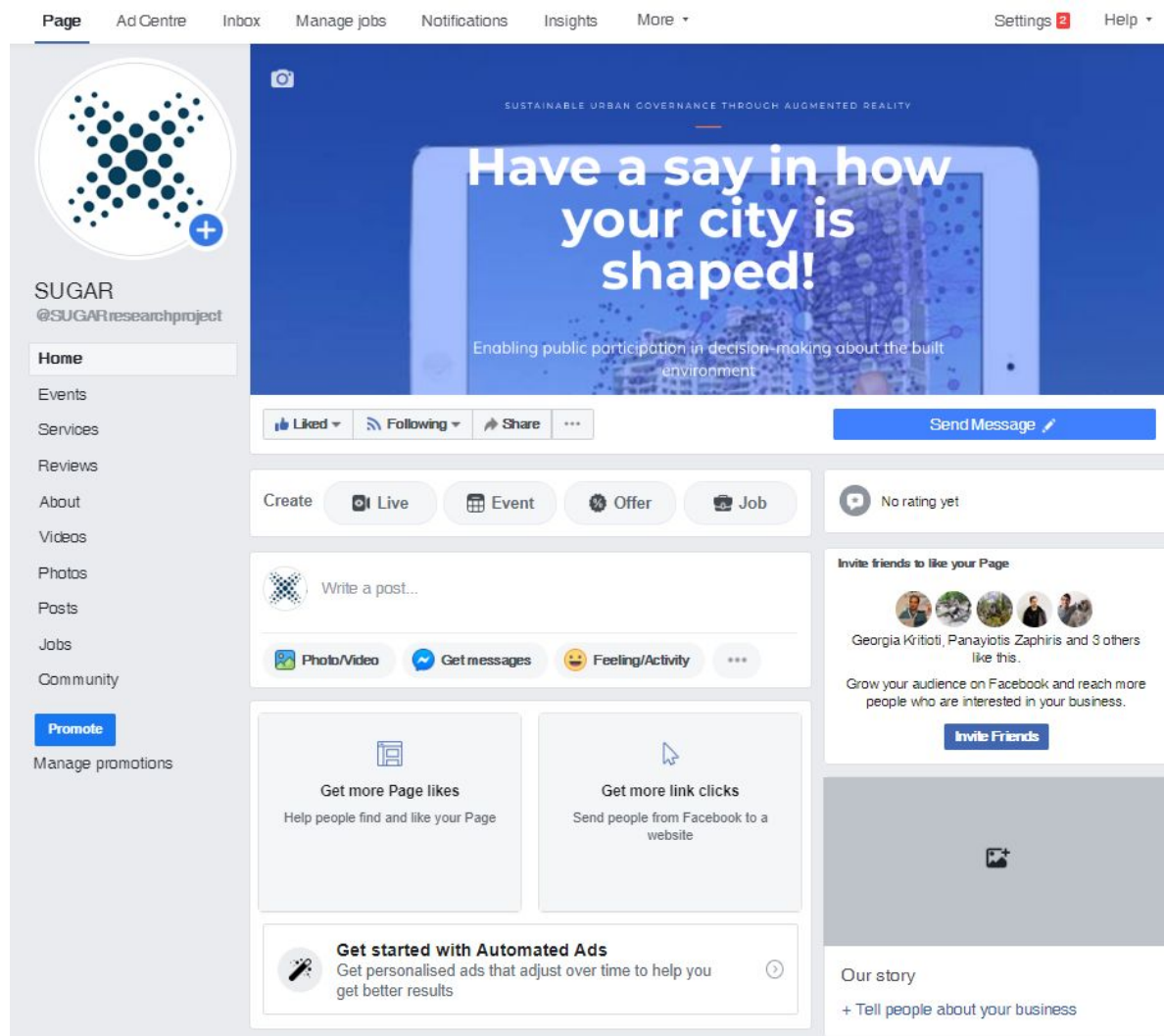

Events

Limassol 2040: Part 1

The SUGAR team, in collaboration with NGO Oxygono and the Youth Council of Cyprus two organisations that have been organising public events with sustainable urban development as subject-matter, have organised a two-part discussion panel series as part of the SUGAR project under the title of “Limassol 2040”, which aim to discuss how a long-term plan for a city can come to fruition through the participation of citizens, the community and the authorities.

The first discussion took place on the 21st of November 2019 at the Cyprus University of Technology in Limassol. The discussants included Prof. Spiro Pollalis from Harvard University, Dr. Vyronas Ioannou, Urban Planner representing the Technical Chamber of Cyprus, Eraklis Achiotis the Regional Officer of the Town Planning Department of Limassol and Kyriakos Xidias, Mayor of Yermasogia. In what can be described as a very successful event supported by a large attendance of around 150 interested members of the public and key stakeholders and a particularly insightful discussion between the panel of experts, the discussion was centred around five main themes:

1. The main reasons why cities need strategic planning and a clear vision for the future
2. The modern challenges faced by cities
3. The pillars of sustainable urban design
4. The environmental, social and financial issues faced by the city of Limassol due to the rapid expansion of high-rise developments along the coastal front
5. The role of citizens in sustainable urban design

Limassol 2040: Part 2

The SUGAR team, in collaboration with NGO Oxygono and the Youth Council of Cyprus, have organised a two-part discussion panel series under the theme of “Limassol 2040”, which aim to discuss how a long-term plan for a city can come to fruition through the participation of citizens, the community and the authorities. The second part of the discussion took place on the 5th of December 2019 at the Cyprus University of Technology in Limassol. The invited speakers were Nicos Nicolaides (Mayor of Limassol), Pantelis Eutixiou Georgiou (Mayor of Ypsonas) and Charalampos Theopemptou (MP of the Ecologists – Citizens’ Coalition Movement). The discussion evolved around five main themes, including local government reform, tall buildings, sustainable strategic planning, future challenges and the long-term plan for Limassol.

The two Mayors emphasized the need for local government reform and expressed their support for the proposal put forward by the Government so that Municipalities could acquire the necessary responsibilities and financial capacity to perform their duties more efficiently towards improving citizen welfare. From his point of view, Mr. Theopemptou expressed that, although the proposed bill has “good potential”, it also appears to have “many shortcomings”, leaving “many unanswered questions for the Parliament to discuss”.

Concerning future challenges, Mr. Theopemptou strongly underlined that Municipalities need to employ certain measures that address the impacts associated with a poor public transportation system, lack of green space, inadequate waste management system, rising temperatures and air quality. Particularly for the latter, Mr. Theopemptou pointed out that, according to a research carried out by the Cyprus Institute, statistics indicate that on average two Cypriots die prematurely, every day, due to poor air quality.

Moreover, The Mayor of Ypsonas expressed his concern on the forthcoming effects of climate change, particularly rising sea levels. “With the sea levels set to rise, by approximately two metres, over the coming decades”, Mr. Georgiou strongly urged that we need to take measures and protect our coastal cities. Among other things, he also referred to the design of the Limassol Metropolitan Park, which has been put on hold due to the cancellation of the Local Plan, while at the same time assuring that this goal remains a high priority on the agenda of all six Limassol Mayors and will be included in the revised Local Plan as well as the strategic planning proposals 2021-2027.

Regarding the Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan (ΣBAK), the Mayor of Limassol noted that the aim is to solve the issue of excessive car use “which in Limassol exceeds 92%”. Mr. Nicolaides suggested that the implementation of such a Plan, requires the necessary funds and technocratic approach, but above all, a strong political will. He also indicated that the Plan entails major changes “that are in conflict with the mind-sets of Cypriots, who are accustomed to drive

everywhere exclusively in their cars”. Regarding the controversial topic of tall buildings, Mr. Nicolaides did not exclude the possibility of strategically locating future high-rise developments on the Coastal Road, also known as Aktaia Odos (a road ranging from Limassol Marina to the Port of Limassol). The Mayor recalled that the former, as well as the current City Council felt that this strategic approach could be achieved successfully through proper procedures. “It is an issue that is currently being discussed and should be assessed in light of the current situation”, he added. Mayor of Ypsonas said that although there is a need for tall buildings, so far these have been constructed in the wrong locations. Instead, “they should be strategically positioned in such a way as to form a strong financial district – in order to attract other companies”, he also commented.

We allowed the businessmen to build towers where they wanted, without sufficient strategic planning and design, said Mr. Theopemptou, who also noted that on a daily basis every construction site of a high-rise building dumps 2500 tonnes of water into the sea, the quality of which is controlled by the associated companies themselves. He indicated that everyone was rushing to obtain planning permits because the legislation for almost zero energy consumption buildings was planned to be implemented from the coming year.

At the end of the discussion, the audience had the opportunity to ask the invited speakers a series of questions in relation to the topics discussed as well as their views on the future of the city.

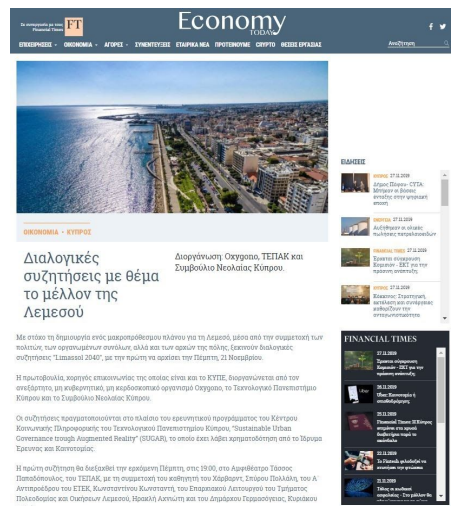
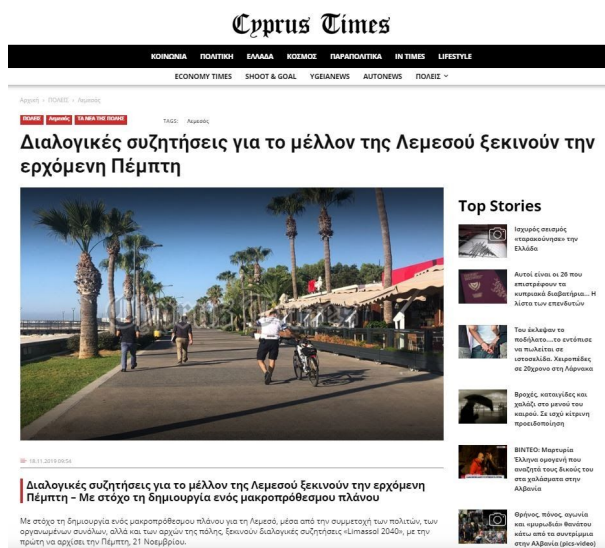

Τις ανησυχίες και τις θέσεις των πολιτών κατέγραψε χθες βράδυ, το πρώτο σκέλος διαλογικών συζητήσεων, υπό τον τίτλο «Limassol 2040», με τους ομιλητές να επικεντρώνονται σε πέντε θεματικές, που αφορούν τον στρατηγικό σχεδιασμό και το όραμα μιας πόλης, τις προκλήσεις των πόλεων, τα ψηλά κτίρια, τον βιώσιμο αστικό σχεδιασμό και τον ρόλο των πολιτών στον σχεδιασμό του.

Η πρωτοβουλία, χορηγός επικοινωνίας της οποίας είναι και το ΚΥΠΕ, διοργανώθηκε από τον ανεξάρτητο, μη κυβερνητικό, μη κερδοσκοπικό οργανισμό Οργανισμός, το Τεχνολογικό Παιδαγωγικό Κύπρου και το Συμβούλιο Νεολαίας Κύπρου και στόχο έχει τη δημιουργία ενός μακροπρόθεσμου πλάνου για τη Λεμεσό, μέσα από τη συμμετοχή των πολιτών, των οργανωμένων συνόλων, αλλά και των αρχών της πόλης.

Οι τέσσερις εισηγητές ανέπτυξαν τις θέσεις τους γύρω από τη θεματολογία, όπου μεταξύ άλλων, επισημάνθηκε η ανάγκη για τερατοματό της αλόγιστης επέκτασης των πόλεων, την πύκνωση τους, την αποτροπή περαιτέρω διαρρηχθής χωροθέτησης ψηλών κτιρίων και την ύστατη και εφαρμογή ενός ολοκληρωμένου στρατηγικού σχεδιασμού.

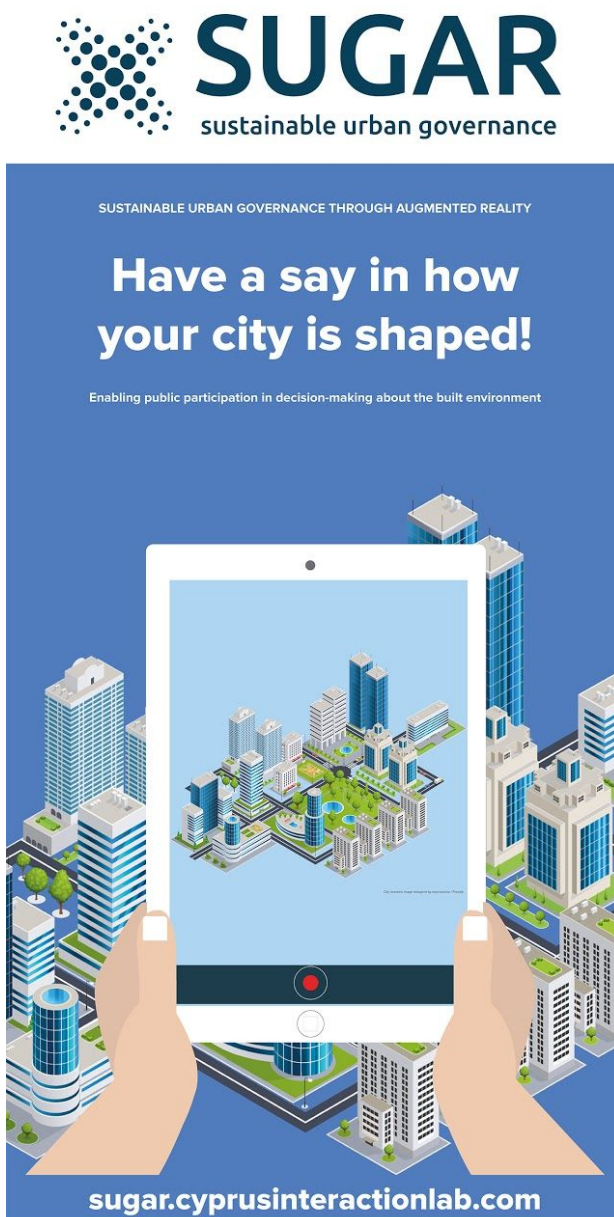

SUGAR is a research project in urban governance, Augmented Reality (AR) and public participation that aims to develop a Sustainable Urban Governance framework utilising AR, design an ICT solution and implement it through activities in workshops based in Cyprus.

Networking

At a local and regional level, the project has strengthened its networking, collaboration and cooperation between academics, educators, entrepreneurs and other stakeholders involved with participatory planning and technology. A number of municipal authorities (across Nicosia, Larnaca and Limassol), which relate to urban planning and urban governance, as well as local communities, were involved in meetings to source a real case-study and the project's workshop. This reinforced the societal impact of the project and activated knowledge through interaction with society.

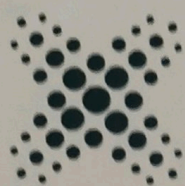
At a national level relevant stakeholders were reached through small scale activities, such as project presentations, roundtable discussions and other dissemination sessions aimed at raising awareness of the project's aims and outcomes. The project also fostered transnational cooperation between academic and research institutions while engaging the public and widening access to international expertise for students, staff and professionals alike. Through the 12-months of SUGAR, the US team at Harvard University has visited Cyprus once and the team from Cyprus at the two state universities has visited Boston once.

At an international level the project fostered a multidisciplinary view on participatory planning and AR as a method for achieving sustainable urban governance through activities that allow the public to be actively involved in the design and decision-making process and express opinions. The framework could in the future be implemented by international organisations involved in urban design and planning such as the UN-HABITAT, UNDP, UNESCO, the Global Planners Network and professional associations.

The immediate benefit of the network is that it has created the conditions for an integrated, shared framework of achieving sustainable urban governance through AR. Furthermore, this network has developed a discussion platform for practitioners, policymakers and other stakeholders, concerned with sustainable urban governance and participatory planning in Cyprus and the US. Bringing these stakeholders together at a unique setting, has fostered scientific and technological advances and built a bridge between research, analysis and policy-making.
